

Caring for Denver Foundation's reconciled sales tax revenue was \$36,822,629. Of that \$36 million, 5% was allocated for administration, 10% was allocated for City and County of Denver alternatives to jail facilities, and 85% was available for grant awards. 2020 was dedicated to engaging community partners to refine our funding priorities, as well as creating policies and procedures to ensure integrity and stewardship in our funding. We awarded grants in three community-prioritized funding opportunities (outlined below). The unspent allocated funds (approximately \$15 million) will be granted in funding areas in 2021.
