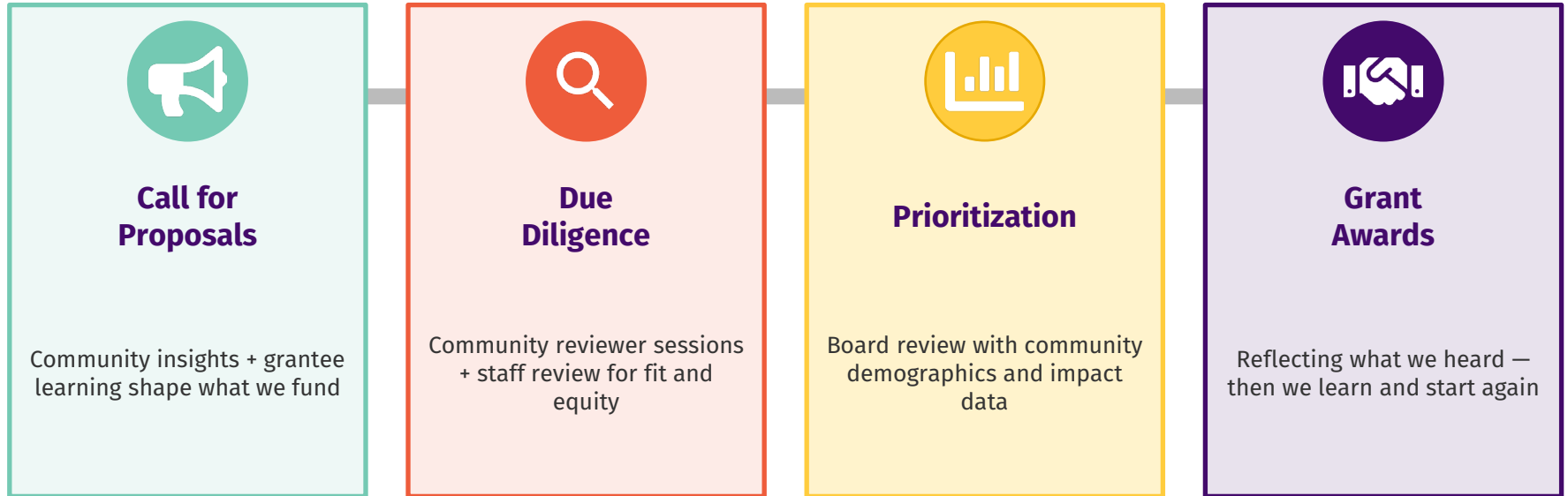

Every grant decision starts and ends with community.

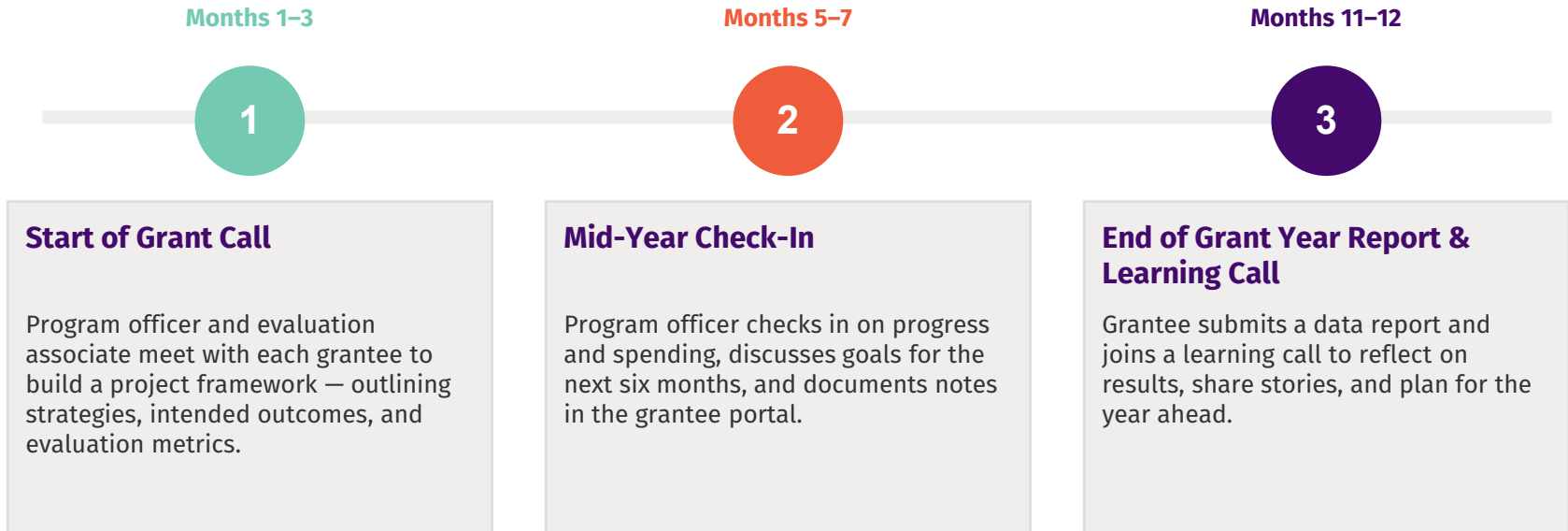
Denver shapes our funding priorities, community members review applications, and lived experience guides every decision.
